



SKAL International Australia Platinum Club of the Year Award Criteria

This is an annual Australian award, and the criteria differs from the SKAL International Club of the Year Award. It is highly likely that the SKAL International Australia award recipient may not meet the criteria of the International awards.

- The Club must have been operating for more than one year and have attended at least two National Assemblies
- The Club must have all National payments paid and received by the due dates
- The Club must have all International payments paid and received by the due dates
- The Club must advise updated membership lists by the due dates
- All AGM documents, membership renewal information and financials must be sent to SIA National by the end of February each year
- Membership number retention on the previous year
- Membership growth is not paramount but is considered favorably
- Input to National Assembly meetings
- Creativity in organizing Club monthly meetings
- Succession Planning at Club level, with a view to the profile and professionalism of SKAL International Australia
- Commitment to SKAL International Australia at all levels

While it is not essential, Clubs are encouraged to submit their Business and Financial Plan no later than 31 December.
